To Qualify to Play OSA Playdowns

- ❖ **Non League Players** Must Have Played in **5** OSA Sanctioned Tournaments
- ❖ **League Members** Must Have Played in **3** OSA Sanctioned Tournaments

Show Good Sportsmanship

- ❖ Please Try To Stand 3 Feet Away From The Board When Someone is Shooting
- ❖ Show Sportsmanship at All Times.
- ❖ Anyone Causing Trouble with Other Players or Disrupting The Tournament Will Be Given **ONE** Warning Only.
- ❖ If That Person Continues To Cause Trouble They will Be Suspended From Playing for **ONE** Year on the First Offense
- ❖ Please **turn off or put your cell phones on silent** and **please do not make or receive calls while game is in progress.**

- ❖ Nov/03 -Any participant not completing the full tournament will result in any wins becoming losses and the player/team that loses against this team will be given a win.
 - ❖ The participant leaving will be advised of the possible consequences of not completing the tournament which is as follows
 - ❖ Disqualification from playing in an OSA tournament for 1 year from the day after the event, including OSA Playdowns, except in emergency instances, to be decided by the executive
 - ❖ Within 3 days of the event the executive will meet to consider the circumstances surrounding the failure to finish and will make a decision as to whether it was justified.
 - ❖ The player will be notified within one week of the decision
