Geoff was 2nd Vice President of the Canadians I believe from 1987 to 1989

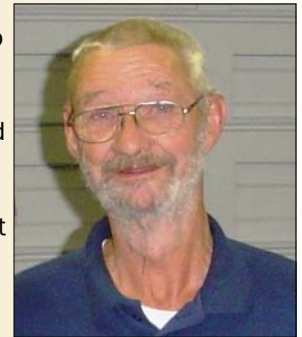
In 1969 he won the Ontario Men's Singles Championship and traveled to Thunder Bay to participate in the Canadian Playdowns.

In 1980 the Ontario Charter was re-instated and Geoff played the Men's Singles in Vancouver.

In 1986 Geoff again won the Ontario Men's Singles and played in the Canadian Playdowns in Milton.

Geoff has competed in the Canadian Shuffleboard Playdowns in Victoria, Vancouver, Regina, Calgary, Winnipeg and Milton in the Men's Doubles partnered with Tony Lambert and John Vlietstra from Acton and John Butler from Fonthill
